INTRODUCTION

REGISTRATION

Registration for the 2024-2025 Premiere Performance Team begins on Saturday, April 6th, 2024 and ends on Monday, July 29th, 2024. Registration will take place online through your parent portal. Class commitments and Intensive registration must be met in order to complete Performance Team enrollment.

- Pearl Team - Dancers between the ages of 4-6 years on August 7th
- Crystal Team - Dancers between the ages of 7-9 years on August 7th
- Diamond Team - Dancers between the ages of 10+ years on August 7th

COMMITMENT

The Premiere Performance Team requires dedication from all of its members. Members of the Performance Team are held to a higher standard. All members must be willing to commit to the weekly classes outlined below and a bi-weekly 45 minute rehearsal. In addition, Performance Team members must be able to attend all outlined performances during the year. If a dancer must withdraw from the Performance Team, the financial obligation will be handled on a situational basis at the discretion of the studio owners.

ATTENDANCE

The attendance of Premiere's Performance Team Members members is crucial to the growth of the team as a whole. Dancers must be attending weekly classes on a regular basis. In addition, team members are allowed 3 rehearsal absences throughout the year. When a dancer misses more than 3 absences, he or she is required to set up private lessons with Katelyn or Lauren to review missed rehearsal information.

REQUIRED CLASSES

Rehearsals - Bi-weekly rehearsals start date TBD

- Pearl Team Rehearsal - every other Sunday from 1:15-2:00p
- Crystal Team Rehearsal - every other Sunday from 2:00-2:45p
- Diamond Team Rehearsal - every other Sunday from 2:45-3:30p
- **Schedule may change due to performance opportunities and/or holidays and will be outlined / updated on the calendar throughout the season as needed.*

Weekly Technique Classes - Weekly class levels will be determined during yearly evaluations.

- Introductory Level (KinderCombo & Intermediate Progression)
 - 1 Introductory Class (Ballet & Tap Combo) / Week
 - 1 "Elective" Class / Week
- Level I-IV:
 - 1 Ballet Technique Class / Week
 - 1 Jazz Class / Week
 - 2 "Elective" Classes / Week

Summer Camps / Classes - All Performance Team members are required to attend the Performance Team Intensive on August 2nd, 2024. Dancers will learn the Parade Choreography during Intensive.

- Ages 4-6 4:00-5:00p
- Ages 7-9 5:00-6:30p
- Ages 10+ 6:30-8:00p

PARENT MEETING | AUGUST 2ND

There will be a mandatory parent meeting on August 2nd, 2024 from 8:00-8:30p for the families of all dancers registering for the Performance Team in the 2024-2025 season. Dancers do not need to attend the meeting.

PERFORMANCE TEAM ATTIRE

Weekly Technique Classes - Dancers will be expected to follow the Premiere Dance Project dress code for weekly classes.

Rehearsals - Dancers will be expected to wear **all black, form-fitting dance wear** to rehearsals. This can include: leotards, booty shorts, bra tops, tank tops, and leggings. This dress code gives dancers a clean, uniform appearance that is ideal for the instructor when cleaning and working with choreography.

Performances - Dancers will be expected to wear Performance Team apparel and appropriate costume to each performance. Performance Team Hair & Makeup will be at the discretion of the instructor and will be announced with costumes at the start of the season.

REQUIRED PERFORMANCES

Premiere Open House | Saturday, August 10th

Dancers will perform their Parade Choreography during the Premiere Open House. Open House will be from 11:00a-3:00p. Exact performance times TBD.

Waukee Homecoming Parade | Date TBD

Dancers will perform the Parade Choreography during the Waukee Homecoming Parade (Thursday evening of Homecoming Weekend). *Note: this is for Waukee High School homecoming only - NOT Waukee Northwest.*

Premiere Showcase | January 2025 - Date TBD

Dancers will perform the Routine Choreography during the annual Premiere Showcase held in January.

Sporting Event Halftime (x2)

Dancers will perform the Routine Choreography during an Iowa Wolves and Wild game between the months of November - April.

- Iowa Wolves | Date TBD
- Iowa Wild | Date TBD

Premiere Palooza | May 2025 - Date TBD

Dancers will perform the Routine Choreography during the Parking Lot Party at Premiere.

Recital | June 2025 - Date TBD

Dancers will perform the Routine Choreography during Premiere's annual recital held in June. Each team will perform their routine in two separate recital shows.

- Pearl Team | Shows 3 & 5
- Crystal Team | Shows 1 & 5
- Diamond Team | Shows 2 & 4

Other performance opportunities may become available throughout the season. These performance opportunities will not be mandatory. We will communicate all opportunities as soon as possible. Extra performances will not affect your "Performance Fee".

COMMUNICATION PROCEDURES

- **Email:** All major communications will be sent & received via email.
 - Concerns should be addressed via email to the office account at office@premieredancerproject.com
 - Questions that are more personal in nature and/or not urgent should be sent via email.
- **App:** Reminders and quick communications will be sent via a GroupMe communication app. App information will be sent out at the start of the season.
 - All communication on the app should remain positive and support the overall culture of the team.
 - Questions that are urgent and pertain to all members can be asked in the chat.

- **Google Calendar:** All important dates will be listed on the Performance Team Google Calendar. Google Calendar information will be sent out at the beginning of the season.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION / PRICING

- Performance Team Tuition | \$385 / year
 - The tuition for the Premiere Performance Team is separate from your regular class tuition and is taxable.
 - This fee covers seasonal planning, staffing, and rehearsal time.
- Choreography Fee | \$150 / year
 - This fee covers both the Parade and Routine Choreography
- Costume Fee | \$125 / costume
 - Tan Pulse Jazz Shoe required (not included in costume fee)
 - Tan Tights required (not included in costume fee)
- Performance Fee | \$160
 - Homecoming Parade, Premiere Showcase, Sporting Event Halftime (x2), Premiere Palooza

Additional Fees: Additional fees will not be included in your final financial outline. These will be charged separately to your online account.

- Performance Team Intensive | \$60 ages 4-6; \$75 ages 7+, due at registration
- Performance Team Registration Fee | \$50 registration fee, due at registration
- Team Apparel | approximately \$160, billed at time of order
 - Performance Team Jacket (approximately \$140) - includes dancer's name and logo
 - Required for New Members
 - *Optional* for Returning Members from 2023-2024 season
 - Parade T-Shirt (approximately \$20)
 - Required for All Members
- Recreational Class Tuition | price varies by class selection
 - Recreational class tuition is billed separate from Performance Team fees; charged on the first of each month, following our regular tuition policy

Yearly Financial Obligations: After joining the Premiere Performance Team, dancers and families will need to fill out a financial agreement to review all charges. The sum of Performance Team tuition, choreography, costumes, performance fees, performance and team apparel are added together for a grand total. 25% of this total will be due on Friday, August 9th. The remaining balance is then divided into 10 equal payments charged on the 15th of each month from September to June.

Your 25% deposit will be placed on accounts Monday, August 5th & due by Friday, August 9th. Equal payments on the remaining balance will be made on the 15th of each month from September - June.

Signed Performance Team Agreements will be due by Friday, August 9th.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Premiere Dance Project holds Performance Team members & families to high moral standards. At classes, rehearsals, and performances, dancers & families should respect all team members and instructors. At performances or outside events Premiere dancers & families should respect all facilities and people in attendance. This includes cleaning up in dressing rooms and auditoriums at all venues. A breach in any of the rules outlined above could result in disciplinary action or removal from the Premiere Performance Team entirely.

Any and all circumstances not discussed in the handbook will be handled at the discretion of the studio owners.
